


CO2 emissions (kg per PPP \$ of GDP)



Euro-Mediterranean challenges on climate change – historical emissions



COP22 Milestones



Union for the Mediterranean Union pour la Méditerranée الإتحاد من أجل المتوسط

1. Paris Agreement is on track

- Ratification by 110 countries (including 23 UfM Member States)
- Clear commitments of non-governmental actors, especially private companies
- Enhanced action foreseen by the EU + at least 48 least developed countries
- Uncertainty from the Brexit and US agenda, but supportive action from China

2. Euro-Mediterranean Climate Agenda is on track

- New interconnections are emerging
- Water and blue economy agenda enhanced
- UfM Energy platform launched (including UfM Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency platform)
- UfM labelled project « SPREF » fostering private investments in renewable energy launched
- New projects foreseen (ex: Mediterranean Covenant of Mayors, MedECC, etc.)
